

The History of Rhodes

Rhodes-on-the-Pawtuxet was formerly an even larger complex of social and recreational buildings, located on the northern bank of the Pawtuxet River in the historic Pawtuxet Village, a beautiful coastal area known for its important contributions to the Revolutionary War (site of the capture and burning of the British ship the HMS Gaspee by colonists in 1772.)

In 1872, Thomas H. Rhodes recognized Pawtuxet's recreational appeal when he opened a modest one-story frame pavilion for clambakes and flat-bottomed canoe rentals. "Rhodes-on-the-Pawtuxet," as the operations were soon known, quickly expanded to include facilities for dancing, bowling, rowing, and canoeing, and was considered by many to "be the place to be." During the height of its operations, 750 canoes were launched daily from the basement of Rhodes to the water below for scenic tours along the beautiful Pawtuxet River.

In 1898, the year of Thomas H. Rhodes' death, various alterations and expansions had been made, and the newly incorporated Rhodes Brothers enlarged the grounds and built a new casino for dancing.

In 1901, a second new, and larger casino was built, as the earlier one had already been outgrown.

Sadly, on February 11, 1915, a fire started in one of the boathouses, and many of the outbuildings were completely destroyed. On August 14, 1915, the present building, the Rhodes Ballroom, designed in the Classical Revival style by the architect John O'Malley, opened to the public with 10,000 guests in attendance.

Rhodes has been the host to many famous bands and entertainers throughout the years, including Nat King Cole, Benny Goodman, Ella Fitzgerald, Artie Shaw, Glenn Miller, Frank Sinatra, Tony Bennett, The McGuire Sisters, Jerry Vale, Tony Abbott, The Beach Boys, Paul Mitchell, Bonnie Raitt, Louis Armstrong, and more!

Rhodes on the Pawtuxet has recently undergone a restoration, highlighting many of its unique features, including 10,000 square feet of original hardwood floors (considered by many to be one of the finest dance floors in New England), 21' ceilings with unobstructed views, and a beautiful mural of Narragansett Bay, painted by the renowned watercolor artist, Hezekiah A. Dyer. A secret panel, recently discovered, leads to a catwalk, loft, and hidden room, and is thought to have been used during Prohibition. The marble bar is original to the building, and boasts the first liquor license ever granted in Rhode Island. The Rhodes gazebo, the "Trolley Stop", (c. 1880), and the statue of Terpsichore, survived the fire, and are original to the site.

Rhodes on the Pawtuxet was added to the National Registry of Historic Places in 1978.










THE INTERIOR OF THE ORIGINAL RHODES BALLROOM - CIRCA 1916 AND 1918



VENUE RENTAL FEES

Venue Fees are subject to a 21% House Fee, and 7% RI State Sales Tax. *The House Fee is utilized by the venue to cover operating expenses directly related to your function. It does not represent a gratuity or service charge for employees. If your organization is tax-exempt, a copy of the valid exemption certificate must be received in advance of the event. Tax identification numbers will not be accepted.*

FIRE & POLICE DETAIL OFFICERS:

The City of Cranston requires Rhodes to have special duty police and fire officers on duty for events that meet certain criteria. The number of officers assigned is determined by a client's estimated count, and the Chiefs of each department will have the final decision on the number of officers assigned. Rhodes will order special detail officers on the client's behalf (as mandated by the City of Cranston.) Charges for special detail officers will be charged to the client.

Frequently Asked Questions

***IS THIS A “HALL”?**

No. Rhodes on the Pawtuxet is a beautiful banquet venue, featuring an exclusive caterer and in-house bar services, elegant décor, plentiful free off-street parking, and handicapped accessible facilities (1st Floor). Rhodes on the Pawtuxet is available year-round for all types of special events.

***WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE VENUE RENTAL?**

The Venue Rental includes the use of our standard banquet chairs, table inventory (20 – 72” rounds, 60 – 60” rounds, and 12 – 8’ banquets are available. Additional tables / specific table sizes may be rented at client’s expense), LAP-LENGTH linens (white, ivory, or black with a matching napkin), as well as the basic set-up and breakdown for your event. Wedding Packages INCLUDE floor-length linens (white, ivory, or black.) Bartending staff will be provided by Rhodes on the Pawtuxet at no additional charge (1 Bartender per every 100 Guests is required. ADDITIONAL Bartenders, and / or Cocktail Staff may be secured for \$75.00 - \$100.00 per Staff Member – ADVANCE NOTICE IS REQUIRED.) Venue Fees are subject to a 21% House Fee, and 7% RI State Sales Tax. ***The House Fee is utilized by the venue to cover operating expenses related to your function. It does not represent a gratuity or service charge for employees.***

***CAN I BRING IN MY OWN FOOD?**

Due to liability reasons, we do require our clients to use our exclusive caterer, Ralph’s Catering, as they are under contract, and are properly food safety certified and insured. Ralph’s Catering includes the use of the china, silverware, & glassware for the event, and extensively trained kitchen and wait staff. All items are prepared on-site in our renovated kitchen. A large variety of menus are available, and Ralph’s Catering can usually accommodate most special menu requests to fit a particular theme or dietary request.

***CAN I BRING IN MY OWN BEVERAGES?**

No. Rhodes on the Pawtuxet MUST provide all beverages. **To ensure the safety of our Guests and Employees, and in compliance with State and Local Liquor Laws, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY NOT BE BROUGHT ONTO OUR PREMISES AT ANY TIME. FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THIS REQUIREMENT MAY RESULT IN EARLY CLOSURE OF THE BAR, per the event contract.**

A full-service bar is available featuring all of your favorite selections. The bar may be run on a cash (Guests pay for their own beverages), open (or “host” bar – the Client pays for the Guests’ beverages) basis, or any combination of the two (beverage packages are available, or, the bar may be run on a consumption basis if preferred.) Rhodes accepts cash, credit / debit, and Apple pay for bar arrangements. Restrictions do apply (please ask your sales representative for more information). All open (or “host”) bars are subject to a 21% Administrative Fee, 7% Rhode Island State Sales Tax, & 1% Local Food & Beverage Sales Tax. Guests must be 21 years of age to purchase and consume alcoholic beverages. PROPER ID IS REQUIRED. PER VENUE POLICY: No “shots” neat” or “straight up” beverages will be served. All liquors must be served over ice or with a mixer. Guests may only have access to alcoholic beverages for a maximum of 5 hours for any event, and the bar must close a half an hour prior to the event end time.

Frequently Asked Questions

***WHAT IS THE LATEST THAT WE CAN STAY FOR AN EVENING EVENT?**

Evening events (as noted in the event contract) must end no later than midnight.

***IF I SUBMIT A DEPOSIT TO SECURE AN AVAILABLE DATE, AND THE EVENT IS CANCELLED, DO I GET A REFUND?**

Events booked are tentative until the required deposit (amount varies based on the type of event) is received. Event deposits are considered non-refundable. In the event of a cancellation by the Client, the deposit may be applied to another available date within twelve calendar months without a penalty.

***WHAT FORMS OF PAYMENT ARE ACCEPTED?**

Full payment of an estimated bill must be received a minimum of three (3) business days in advance of the function. Payments may be in the form of Certified Bank Check (made payable to Rhodes on the Pawtuxet, Inc., please), VISA, Mastercard, Discover, or American Express. **Rhodes on the Pawtuxet, Inc. will accept a total of \$4,000.00 in credit card payment(s) without a processing fee. A 3.5% processing fee will be added to any additional credit card payments in excess of \$4,000.00 that are applied to a single event. Personal checks will NOT be accepted for final payments.**

***WHEN CAN MY VENDORS MAKE DELIVERIES / SET-UP FOR MY EVENT?**

Deliveries of all NON-PERISHABLE items may be delivered the day before an event, between the hours of 9:30 am – 4:00 pm. In the case of a Sunday event, deliveries will be accepted the FRIDAY before the event, 9:30 am – 4:00 pm. We request that you kindly contact the Sales Office at 401.785.4333 to schedule any deliveries. **PLEASE NOTE: Items delivered prior to the day of the event will NOT be set-up in advance (due to other regularly scheduled events taking place), but will be stored in a safe place. Rhodes on the Pawtuxet is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items. Deliveries, decorating, and Vendor set-ups will be accepted three hours prior to the actual start time. Extra set-up hours may be purchased for \$250.00 per additional hour (subject to availability.)**

***WHAT IS REQUIRED FOR BREAKDOWN FOR MY EVENT?**

All event décor must be removed immediately following the conclusion of the event. Please schedule accordingly, as the facility must be available for events the following day. Vendors and decorators are allowed a maximum of two hours to dismantle equipment and décor and vacate the premises.

***ARE THERE ANY DECORATING RESTRICTIONS?**

RHODES ON THE PAWTUXET is a beloved Rhode Island landmark, and is over one hundred years old.

This beautiful building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. We strive to ensure that this building, and its property, continue to be treated with the utmost care and respect. We respectfully request that you, your guests, invitees, and any third party vendors you hire do the same.

- **TRANSPORTING DECORATIONS AND EQUIPMENT IN OUR VENUE:** Carts / dollies that are used for the set-up / breakdown portions of the event must have soft rubber wheels to prevent scratches.
- **CANDLES:** Candles MUST be enclosed in glass candleholders or other approved containers. Candles that are not enclosed will not be permitted.
- **GLITTER AND CONFETTI (OF ANY SIZE):** May NOT be used under any circumstances.
- **ROSE PETALS:** May be used for Wedding Ceremonies only.

- **HELIUM BALLOONS:** May NOT be used under any circumstances, due to very sensitive sprinkler and alarm systems.
- **BALLOON ARCHES:** Are acceptable. HOWEVER, GLITTER SPRAYS / SHELLAC SPRAYS MAY NOT BE USED.
- **SMOKE / FOG / DRY ICE MACHINES:** May NOT be used under any circumstances, due to very sensitive sprinkler and alarm systems.
- **PUSH PINS, NAILS, GLUE, VELCRO (With the exception of Scotch Hooks):** May NOT be used under any circumstances.
- **TAPE:** Gaffers Tape is the only approved tape that may be used on the walls or doors.
- **DRAPERY / PIPE & DRAPE:** Must be professionally installed and marked “NON-FLAMMABLE”.
- **FLOATING DANCE FLOORS:** May NOT be used under any circumstances.
- **VINYL FLOOR WRAPS OR STICKERS:** May NOT be used under any circumstances.
- **SPARKLERS (INCLUDING “COLD” SPARKLERS), FIREWORKS, OR OTHER PYROTECHNICS:** May NOT be used under any circumstances.
